Programme Structure

The ECA CTMP is a blended learning programme intended to be unique and dynamic in its approach, with a focus on developing, promoting and inspiring ambitious club professionals to explore their potential and to positively contribute to the future of club football.

The three main elements are; an intensive and immersive inperson learning week at Nova School of Business and Economics, near Lisbon, Portugal, 3 online sessions and a 12month mentoring programme with a former or current executive of a football club who will guide and provide an insight into their role and network.

Application Criteria

Applicants must

ECA®

- Demonstrate a passion, desire and potential to succeed to executive and leadership positions in the club.
- Commit to the full programme and complete all core elements (including any course-work and mentoring appointments).
- Receive the support of their club to participate in the programme.
- Have a good level of English speaking and comprehension.

Applicants should

- Have been involved with their club for between 1-5 years (experience at another club or industry may be taken into consideration).
- Ideally be Manager level or equivalent.
- Have an open-ended employment contract.

Applicants could

• Hold either a specialist or generalist role.





Application Process
